




STANDARD KING - BLUE CONCEPT 56 ROOMS 4 PIECES









STANDARD KING ROOM #2, 4, 6, 8, 10, 12











BRETT FLANIGAN


Brett Flanigan was born in Great Falls, Montana and grew up in various locations around the western United States until landing in Brooklyn, NY in 2009. Flanigan's background in science and mathematics can be cited when acknowledging underlying themes of order/disorder, biological allegory and his obsession with and creating algorithms within his work. His abstract and process based practice is driven by intuitive mark making that is loosely guided by a set of self imposed precepts, which are often bent or broken in moments of clarity or carelessness, or as an act of defiance. At first glance, shapes and patterns seem at ease, but upon further inspection, deeper stories unfold. His work tends to manifest in the form of painting, sculpture, or large-scale murals.




MAYA HAYUK

Maya Hayuk's paintings and massively scaled murals recall views of outer space, traditional Ukrainian crafts, airbrushed manicures, and mandalas. Hayuk weaves visual information from her immediate surroundings into her elaborate abstractions, creating an engaging mix of referents from popular culture and advanced painting practices alike while connecting to the ongoing pursuit of psychedelic experience in visual form. She has painted her iconic outdoor murals all over the world and, when not traveling, maintains an active studio in Brooklyn, sketching in paint to inform the large-scale works.





DOUBLE ROOM - GREEN CONCEPT 10 ROOMS 5 PIECES




PETER WARREN

Peter Warren's interest is to create iconic abstract images which speak for themselves. His central forms are small epiphanies which turn into symbols, like new words. The backgrounds are littered with traces of time, meaning, and gesture, allowing the eye to wander. Through woodworking and sewing techniques, he pushes the physical possibilities of his surfaces.


Joining separate canvases on a common plane creates narratives and chance interactions between materials. While his colors, shapes and spaces, battle for hierarchy, settle and become image.


Warren focuses on craft and materials, using an holistic approach to painting. His drawn, carved and sewn lines show a proficient mark maker; leaving a trace. The thin profile canvases hug the wall and reveal their own construction. Worked from the inside out, his work challenges the notion of paintings as a two-dimensional media.

Warren splits his time between San Francisco and Brooklyn. His work has been exhibited in AE open studios from 2010 until present,. These include Southern Exposure Gallery; Space Gallery SF; Velcro Wall Gallery, SOMA among many others. He has work in the permanent collection of Frank Lloyd Wright's Wescot House Museum in Springfield, Ohio.








After studying Theatre Design at the Academy of Fine Arts in Venice and spent a few years spent in London, working as interior designer honing





CORNER SUITES - RED CONCEPT 20 ROOMS 6 PIECES


SIERRA SIEMER

LORI ANN BELLISSIMO


Toronto-born artist Lori-Ann Bellissimo has exhibited widely internationally.





PI STUDIO ART COLLECTIVE

Their works can be found in a multitude to media including watercolor paper, canvas, acrylic, wood, aluminum, glass, mirror and vinyl wallcovering.


















