The Agave Azul

Native to Mexico, the Agave Azul (blue agave) is admired for its metallic blue hue, unique to the world.



Incredioly versatile, the Agave plant was prized by Aztecs for its nutritious sap (aguamier), strong leaves that could be turned into textiles (bt/e) and building material, and, of course, Tequila. Made from the heart of the Weber Azul agave plant (pirbo), this spirit has been massproduced since the 1600s and is one of the first indigenous distilled spirits of North America.
